



Motivated by how a painting evolves, Roohi follows the through-line with abstract forms, exploring color and scale to completion in a new place, the journey to which was unplanned. This act of 'coming home' to what a painting is meant to be allows Roohi to offer the viewer their own interpretation of her work. Working as a proudly Pakistani-American artist, Roohi finds inspi ation in the country of her birth, from which she creates something uniquely hers.
